## RoHS- supplier declaration

Dear Sir or Madam,

the directive 2011/65/EU, also known as the RoHS-directive, restricts the use of six hazardous materials in the manufacture of various types of electronic and electrical equipment.

The restrictions are on each homogeneous material in all types of electronic and electrical equipment. Corresponding to these restrictions we can confirm, that none of the following substances is included with a higher concentration than marked in our products:

- Lead (0,1 %)
- Mercury (0.1 %)
- Cadmium (0,01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) (0,1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0,1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0,1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0,1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0,1 %)

In accordance to the RoHS- restriction the following exemptions are authorized:

- Lead as an alloying element in steel containing up to 0.35% lead by weight
- Lead as an alloying element in aluminum containing up to 0.4% lead by weight
- Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead my weight
- Lead in counterweights

Depending on the product we are making use of these restriction-concurrent exemptions.
